Marie was featured in many Broadway shows originating the roles in THE BEAUTY PART, NOBODY LOVES AN ALBATROSS, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE GENTLEMAN, SWEET CHARITY, MERT & PHIL at Lincoln Center, LAST LICKS; and played Crystal Allen in the revival of THE WOMEN.

She has appeared Off-Broadway, at Dinner Theatres, Regional Theatres, numerous Summer Stock productions and was featured in the National Tours of SLY FOX with Jackie Gleason, and CAROUSEL with Robert Goulet.

Marie has had a full career in daytime television having created three different characters in two consecutive seasons on the ever popular Gothic TV Drama, 'Dark Shadows', a show that has made her "a-sort-of-cult-figure". Its popularity extends into the 21st Century, recording audio dramas for Big Finish, a production company in England. The stories, all new and original, are an extension of the soap drama, with Shadows characters in new stories, and/or new characters in the DS setting. Immediately following DS, Marie starred as India Delaney on NBC's 'Somerset', a part she created and played for three years.

In between Marie's busy theatrical career, she had an active Special Events Photography career, creating photos for Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center and New York Hospital to be used in their newsletters, bulletins, displays and Annual Reports.

Marie is a member of American Renaissance Theater Company and Emerging Artists Theatre in New York City, where she last portrayed Beverly in THE CHISELERS. More recently, Marie starred with Larry Storch in a benefit performance of LOVE LETTERS for the Actors' Temple, also in NYC.

In 2005, Marie's career memoir "On Stage & In Shadows" was published.
